1.Dongdaegu Train Station

Dongdaegu Train Station is a key transportation hub in Daegu. It is connected to the national railway station, a complex transfer center where express bus transfers are possible, and the city railway. Let's purchase a ticket for Daegu City Circular Course and go on a wonderful tour of Daegu

2.Kim Kwangseok-gil Street

Kim Kwangseok-gil Street is a place to commemorate the late singer-songwriter Kim Kwang-seok, and you can enjoy a unique mural filled with beautiful song lyrics. It is adjacent to Bangcheon Market, and cultural and artistic experiences are possible in various cultural spaces.

3.Dongseongno-Jungangno station

In 1907, the walls of Daegu eupseong were torn down and Dongseong-ro, Seoseong-ro, Namseong-ro, and Bukseong-ro were built in their place. Dongseongno is the busiest street representing Daegu and is filled with shopping, dining, and cultural spaces, including shopping malls, movie theaters, performance halls, and restaurants.

4.Modern Culture Alley

A hill that includes the area where Catholic missionaries resided in the 1900s The Modern Culture Alley is an area of approximately 1.7 kilometers that boasts over 100years of history and spans a stretch of missionary housing, March 1st Independence Movement Road, Gyesan Cathedral, homes of poet Lee Sang-hwa and nationalist Seo Sang-don, The First Presbyterian Church of Daegu, Yangnyeongsi, Jin-golmok Alley, and Jongno.

5.Seomun Market-Cheona Hill Station

One of the largest markets during the Joseon period, Seomun Market is home to over 5,000 shops that carry practically anything shoppers need, not to mention textiles. The night market, the largest of its kind in Korea, is a great place for finding unique handmade crafts and enjoying delicious food and culture events.

6.Duryu Park-E-world

E-world is a European style theme park encompassing the 202-meter-high 83 Tower and various rides and amusement facilities. In Duryu Park, one can visit the Daegu Culture & Arts Center, Outdoor Music Hall, etc. Culture and arts festivals are being held throughout the year, Daegu ChiMac festival and the major festivals of the Fantasia Daegu Festa.

7.Apsan Sunset Observatory

Capturing the history and symbol of Apsan Ppallaeteo Park, the design of Apsan Sunset Observatory portrays the imagery of people wringing out laundry. If you visit here at sunset, you can enjoy the beautiful sunset and a panoramic view of downtown Daegu.

8.Apsan Park - Apsan Observatory

Take the cable car to ascend to Apsan Observatory, where you can catch a panoramic view of downtown Daegu. Especially, after sunset, looking down at the cityscape, you can create unforgettable memories against the backdrop of the Apsan Moon Rabbit with various wishes.

9.Gosangol Dinosaur Park-Metasequoia Road

Gosangol Dinosaur park was created after the discovery of fossilized footprints estimated to belong to herbivorous dinosaurs from the Cretaceous Period in the Mesozoic Era, more than 100 million years ago, in Gosangol on Apsan Mountain. Connected to the Metasequoia Road, it serves as an excellent family outing route with barefoot trails and children's play facilities.

10.Suseongmot Lake

This eco-friendly lake park, representing Daegu, offers a 2-kilometer lakeside walking trail with captivating lighting reflections on the water during the night. From May to October, visitors can enjoy the video music fountain show. Additionally, various festivals unfold, including busking events and the Suseongmot Lake Festival.

11.Daegu Art Museum

12.Dongchon Recreational Area

It is Daegu's first recreation area located along the Geumho River, with recreational facilities, boating grounds, and delicious restaurants. It is great for family outings because it has exhibition, cultural, and historical sites such as the riverside trail from Ayang Railroad to Mangudang Park, the National Daegu Meteorological Science Museum, and Yeongnam Jeilgan.
